

RESULTS MANAGEMENT PROCESS – ADVERSE ANALYTICAL FINDING (AAF)



Provisional suspension means the Athlete is banned temporarily from participating in any competition or activity pending an outcome of the case.

The CGF may impose a Provisional Suspension on the Athlete that is limited to the 2022 Games in accordance with section 7.5 of the [CGF AD rules](#).

Lab reports a positive result to the CGF for a sample collected by UKAD under the authority of the CGF. (Results may be reported approximately between 24-72hrs post the sample collection date)

CGF ADMC to review all the relevant documentation in accordance with section 5 of the International Standard for Results Managements (ISRM)

Athlete has a case to answer

No case to answer

CGF will notify the Athlete with respect to a potential Anti-Doping Rule Violation (ADRV). Notification will include the Athlete's right to request the analysis of the B sample.

Athlete, WADA, CGA and NADO to be notified of the decision not to proceed with the ADRV.

CGF to review the Athlete's response to the notification. This may include an investigation.

CGF formally assert an ADRV against the Athlete in accordance with section 7 of the ISRM.

Post a detailed review and possible investigation, CGF decide not to charge the Athlete.

Athlete waive hearing and accept consequences proposed by the CGF.

Athlete fails to dispute assertion and therefore deemed to have admitted to the ADRV and accepted consequences.

Athlete disputes assertion or does not agree to consequences and the case goes to a hearing at the Federation Court or CAS.

CGF issue written decision and no hearing before an independent tribunal required.

Decisions may be appealed to CAS in accordance with section 12 of the [CGF AD rules](#).

Consequences of a an ADRV

Disqualification, meaning the Athlete's results for Birmingham 2022 are invalidated, with all resulting consequences including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes. Further sanctions such as period of ineligibility may be imposed by the IF.

Communication & Publication

- WADA, the NADO and the International Federation of the Athlete will be kept fully apprised as to the status of the pending cases and the results of hearings.
- All parties will also be advised of any written decisions on a case.
- Provisional suspension where imposed, will be announced
- A mandatory part of a sanction is automatic publication.
